City Council District Elections

Last year, on June 19, 2018, the Torrance City Council adopted an ordinance establishing by-district elections for City Council. Previously, each Councilmember was elected for an "at-large" 4year term which means they serve in an "at-large" capacity and are allowed to live anywhere in the City of Torrance. However, when their 4-year term expires, they will be required to live within the boundaries of the district that is on the ballot during that election in order for them to be able to run for a 4-year term to that City Council district seat. The districts will be phased in during the next two election cycles – Districts 2, 4, and 6 will be introduced in 2020 and Districts 1, 3, and 5 will be introduced in 2022. After all of the districts have been introduced, the City Council will be comprised of six Councilmembers who each live in and represent one of the established districts and one Mayor, who will remain elected "at-large". Southwood "Meet and Greet" Recap

On Wednesday, June 12th, Southwood Homeowners Association held a "Meet and Greet" and general membership meeting at Anza Elementary. The main purpose of the meeting was to ask questions of Councilmen George Chen and Geoff Rizzo, both Southwood Homeowners Association members. Other city officials attended including Councilmen Mike Griffiths and Aurelio Mattucci, and City Clerk Rebecca Poirier. After the general meeting concluded, discussion began concerning the new voting districts. Mr. Rizzo provided a detailed background as to why Torrance will be switching from at-large voting to districts. Basically, just like many other cities in the state, Torrance switched to districts rather than face a lawsuit from a voter advocacy group that contended at-large representation led to violations of the California Voting Rights Act. For more information on Torrance's new voting districts, see the sidebar on the previous page.

Other questions from Southwood residents were posed to the Councilmen about such topics as city council meeting disturbances, status of the pre-school on restaurant row and the senior apartments, strategy on tree removal, unlicensed solicitors, and the new bright lights in the Walmart parking lot that are shining into nearby homes.
