Torrance School Board Report

At the School Board Meeting on March 4 the Board heard the Good News Student Presentation from Jefferson Middle School.

They also adopted resolutions calling for the support of two Assembly Bills:

AB 428 would increase and equalize current (AB 602) base funding rates, establish a funding mechanism for preschool programs for children with disabilities, provide additional funding for students with the most intensive needs, and address declining enrollment in Special Education Local Plan Areas (SELPA). In recent years, special education funding has not kept pace with the escalating costs. Since special education services are an entitlement for each child with a disability, local districts must utilize general fund revenues to meet the excess costs.

AB 39 would increase the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) base, supplemental and concentration grant funding, to ensure that TUSD can grow and enrich its instructional programs to provide exceptional education for all students. Current LCFF funding levels do not keep pace with the massive growth in fixed costs such as employer pension contributions, health care, and special education services. California must look forward and specify new, higher LCFF funding.

The School Board also approved its 2019 Legislative Platform for the Torrance Unified School District, as developed by the District's Legislative Action Committee: the mission of the District is to provide an educational program with high expectations for all to learn the academic, social, and emotional skills needed to become lifelong learners by offering a learning environment that inspires -- in its students and families -- the passion and the power to make positive life choices by becoming architects of their future. In order to achieve its mission, the District takes a proactive approach in the state legislative process, and has established the attached legislative platform for the 2019 legislative session: 1) Implement the Local Control Funding Formula; 2) Use Non-Proposition 98 Funding to Help Alleviate CalSTRS Contribution Rate Hikes; 3) Increase Funding for Special Education Programs; 4) Increase California's Investment in Public Education for All Students K-12: 5) Expedite the Release of Facilities; 6) State to Pay for State-Mandated Cost Increases.

Congratulations on West High being named a 2019 California Distinguished School!
