City Council Observer Report

The Torrance City Council has been hard at work responding to the Covid-19 crisis in a number of ways. Following are highlights from the City Council meetings these past few months:

- Residents are encouraged to sign up with Torrance Alerts to receive the latest updates on COVID-19 at www.torranceca.gov/torrancealerts.com.
- The Emergency Operations Center (EOC) meets daily with local hospitals, TUSD and private schools.
- The Torrance Cares 2 Go program was implemented, providing groceries for seniors age 65 and over and special needs residents. This ended May 15. More than 1,200 orders were delivered!
- The City Council is encouraging residents to watch the council meetings on Tuesdays at 7:00 p.m..

Torrance schools are closed until further notice. There has been no formal announcement regarding when our students will be able to return to campus.

Tim Stowe Selected to Serve as Interim Superintendent of Schools

Dr. Tim Stowe will take on the role of Interim Superintendent, effective July 1, 2020. He succeeds Dr. George Mannon, who in December 2019 announced his plans to retire by the end of the current academic year. Dr. Stowe will be the eighth TUSD Superintendent since the District formed in 1947. Dr. Stowe began with the District in 1992 as a teacher at Magruder Middle School and later was promoted to Assistant Principal at Richardson Middle School. Dr. Stowe then went on to serve as Principal for seven years, first at J.H. Hull Middle School then at West High School. He worked as Senior Director of Secondary Schools for six years and, in 2013, was promoted to Chief Academic Officer. Most recently, for the past four years, he has served as the District's Deputy Superintendent. Dr. Stowe holds a doctorate in Educational Leadership from the University of Southern California, received a Master of Science in School Counseling and California Administrative Services Credential from the University of La Verne, and a Bachelor of Arts in History, with a minor in Political Science, from the University of Redlands.

Grading Policy – In a collaborative effort among TUSD administrators, Torrance Teachers Association, teachers, parents (District Communication Committee-DCC) and students, a grading plan was developed to identify a framework and policy to guide the issuance of report card grades for students during the final grading term of the 2019-2020 school year.
