- 2020 Census begins April 1, 2020: Information will be coming to each household mid-March, letting us know how to complete the census. There are three ways to respond to the census: online, by phone, and by mail. More information is on the website, 2020census.gov.

- Resolutions were adopted approving a Conditional Use Permit to allow the construction of three light industrial buildings, a division of lot to allow the subdivision of one parcel into three parcels and a General Plan Amendment from General Commercial to Light Industrial land use designations at 2751 Skypark Drive (where Costco used to be).

Handwashing is one of the best ways to protect yourself and your family from getting sick. Learn when and how you should wash your hands to stay healthy.

Wash Your Hands Often to Stay Healthy

Help yourself and your loved ones stay healthy by washing your hands often, especially during these key times when you are likely to get and spread germs:

- Before, during, and after preparing food
- **Before** eating food
- **Before** and **after** caring for someone at home who is sick with vomiting or diarrhea
- Before and after treating a cut or wound
- After using the toilet
- After changing diapers or cleaning up a child who has used the toilet
- After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- After touching an animal, animal feed, or animal waste
- After handling pet food or pet treats
- After touching garbage

Follow Five Steps to Wash Your Hands the Right Way

Washing your hands is easy and one of the most effective ways to prevent the spread of germs. Clean hands can stop germs from spreading from one person to another and throughout an entire community – from your home and workplace to childcare facilities and hospitals. Follow these five steps every time:

- 1. **Wet** your hands with clean, running water (warm or cold), turn off the tap, and apply soap.
- 2. **Lather** your hands by rubbing them together with the soap. Lather the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails.
- 3. **Scrub** your hands for at least 20 seconds. Need a timer? Hum the "Happy Birthday" song from beginning to end twice.
- 4. Rinse your hands well under clean, running water.
- 5. **Dry** your hands using a clean towel or air dry them.

Board of Education Observer Report

Executive Search for Superintendent of Instruction

The Torrance Unified School District School Board recently announced that it in the process of conducting an Executive Search for the purpose of hiring the School District's next Superintendent of Instruction. Dr. Mannon has announced that he will be retiring as of June 30, 2020.

The Torrance Unified School District Board of Education appointed Dr. George Mannon as Superintendent of Schools in 2005. Previously, he was the superintendent of the Glendora Unified School District, Tustin Unified School District, and Carlsbad Unified School District. Prior to becoming a superintendent, Dr. Mannon worked in public education as a social studies teacher, assistant principal, and principal in Charleston, West Virginia. He also served as executive director for Kanawha County Schools in West Virginia and worked for the Phoenix Union High School District as a principal, assistant superintendent, and deputy superintendent.

In addition to his administrative duties, Dr. Mannon has been actively involved in community affairs through membership in various service organizations. He has been an active member of Rotary International, the Torrance YMCA Board of Managers, the Board of the Torrance Area Chamber of Commerce, and the Torrance Cultural Arts Foundation.

The executive search firm Leadership Associates has been selected to advise and assist the Board in this important process. The School Board looks forward to working with the Torrance community as it moves towards selection of the new leader for our Torrance schools.
