Torrance City Council Candidates Forum

Torrance will be having its first by-district election for Torrance City Council members on March 3, 2020. Torrance residents no longer vote for the six council members at-large. Instead, six districts have been established and residents within a district only vote for the one council member who will represent their district. Elections for districts 2, 4 and 6 will be held in March and elections for districts 1, 3 and 5 take place in 2022. Southwood area falls within the District 2 boundaries.

There are 2 forums planned for District 2 candidates:

- Monday, January 13 (Sponsored by West Torrance HOA) Bert Lynn Middle School
 - 6:30 p.m. candidates arrive, 7:00 p.m. forum begins
- Wednesday, February 5 (Sponsored by Southwood HOA) Anza Elementary School

6:30 p.m. candidates arrive, 7:00 p.m. forum begins

Please plan on attending one or both of the forums. The candidates for District 2 are George Chen and Geoff Rizzo.

City Council Votes for Sales Tax Increase Measure

At the December 3 City Council meeting, council members voted to place a conditional ³/₄ cent sales tax increase on the ballot for March. The additional sales tax would not be levied unless the county wins approval of its own sales tax increase. Since the Torrance city sales tax increase would kick in first, the extra income will go to Torrance instead of the county. The reason for the proposed increase in the Torrance city sales tax is to help pay for the unpaid pension liabilities that are eating into the city's operating budget.


